2023 Unaccompanied Child Parental Consent Form

This form provides your consent for your child or children between the ages of 12 and 16 to have unaccompanied access to Goldsboro Parks & Recreation Pool Facilities. For safety purposes, it is important that you and your children understand and accept the requirements below. Renewed consent is required each year and will be kept on file at the pool. Thank you for your cooperation.

I, _____, parent/guardian of child(ren) listed below, who are between the ages of twelve and sixteen and have passed a basic swim test administered by the pool staff, give permission for them to be on Goldsboro Parks & Recreation Pool Property during normal pool operating hours without a parent, guardian, or other adult supervision. I understand and agree to the following policies:

- The basic swim test is administered by Goldsboro Parks & Recreation Pool certified lifeguards. The content of the test, and determination of passing, is solely and completely at the discretion of the Goldsboro Parks & Recreation Pool Manager.
- All unaccompanied children must comply with all Goldsboro Parks & Recreation Pool policies and instructions from Pool staff while on Goldsboro Parks & Recreation Property, including the pool, playground area, picnic areas, bathhouse, and the parking lot. Failure to do so may result in discharge from the pool or pool grounds, at the discretion of the Pool Manager on duty. Repeated failure may result in revocation of permission of the child to access Goldsboro Parks & Recreation Pools when unaccompanied by a parent or guardian.
- I understand that it is not the responsibility of Goldsboro Parks & Recreation, or any of its staff, to ensure that my child(ren) named below remains on Pool Property, and further that if my child does leave Goldsboro Parks & Recreation Pool Property I hold Goldsboro Parks & Recreation and the City of Goldsboro harmless.
- I further understand that in the event Goldsboro Parks & Recreation Pools must close due to inclement weather or any other cause, Goldsboro Parks & Recreation is not responsible for supervising or transporting my child(ren).
- I agree that if I am called by the Goldsboro Parks & Recreation Pool Manager on duty to pick my child(ren) up, I will do so as soon as possible.
